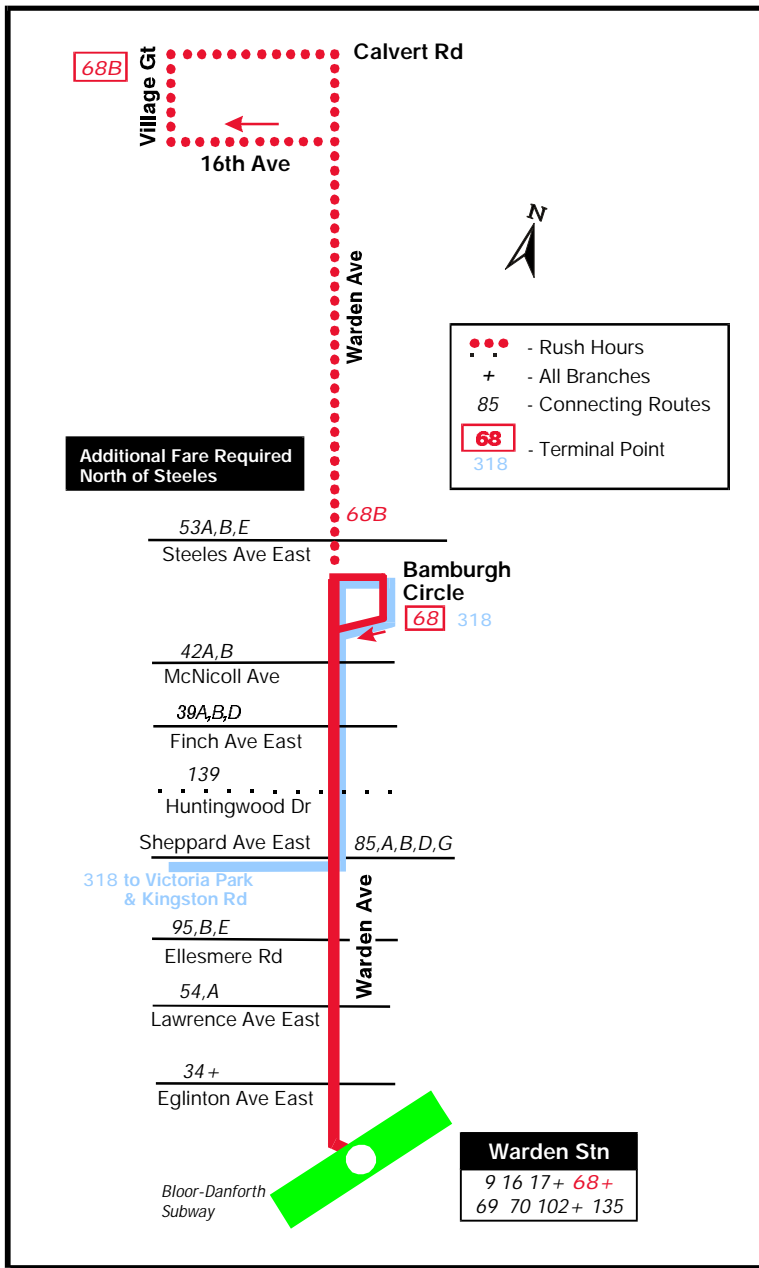




68 Warden

North-end loop change

The northern loop of the 68B Warden (16th Avenue-Warden Stn) branch will be changed to serve a new residential area.

68B service will continue to operate during the peak periods and midday from Monday to Friday, and during the daytime on Saturday.

Branch Service Summary

68 - Warden Stn ↔ Steeles (Bamburgh)

68B - Warden Stn ↔ 16th Avenue

Monday – Friday (68: 4:45 a.m. - 1:51 a.m.)
(68B: 5:07 a.m. - 7:11 p.m.)

- **68** branch runs every 5 minutes during the morning rush, every 7 - 8 minutes during the afternoon rush, every 10 minutes midday, every 15 minutes during the early evening and every 22 minutes during the late evening.
- **68B** branch runs every 29 minutes during the afternoon rush, and every 30 minutes during the morning rush and midday.

Saturday (68: 5:15 a.m. - 2:00 a.m.)
(68B: 7:59 a.m. - 6:50 p.m.)

- **68** branch runs every 13 minutes during the morning and afternoon, every 16 - 17 minutes during the early morning, every 22 minutes during early evening and late evening.
- **68B** branch runs every 39 minutes during the morning and afternoon.

Sunday (68: 7:14 a.m. - 1:51 a.m.)

- **68** branch runs every 16 - 17 minutes during the afternoon, and every 22 minutes during the early morning, morning, early evening and late evening..
- **68B** branch has no Sunday service.

Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
