## ROUTE REPLACED

July 23, 2000

### WEST OF UNION STN

Service west of Union Station will be replaced by the new 509 Harbourfront streetcar route. Service will be also removed from the section of Front Street between Yonge Street and Spadina Avenue, and customers using these stops can use the frequent nearby streetcar and subway services.

**Monday – Friday (6:00 a.m. - 1:00 a.m.)**

- Service operates every 4 - 5 minutes.

**Saturday (6:00 a.m. - 12:45 a.m.)**

- Service runs every 4 - 5 minutes during the day, and every 8 minutes during the early morning.

**Sunday (6:00 a.m. - 12:45 a.m.)**

- Service runs every 4 - 5 minutes during the day, and every 12 minutes during the early morning.

### EAST OF UNION STN

Service east of Union Station will be replaced by:

**Monday to Friday**, an extension of the 72 Pape bus route, and on **Saturdays** an extension of the 65 Parliament bus route. Service will be removed from the section of Commissioners between Carlaw Avenue and Lakeshore Garage, and customers using these bus stops can use the 72 Pape route at Carlaw & Commissioners, or the 83 Jones route at Lakeshore Garage.

**Monday – Friday (5:23 a.m. - 7:46 p.m.)**

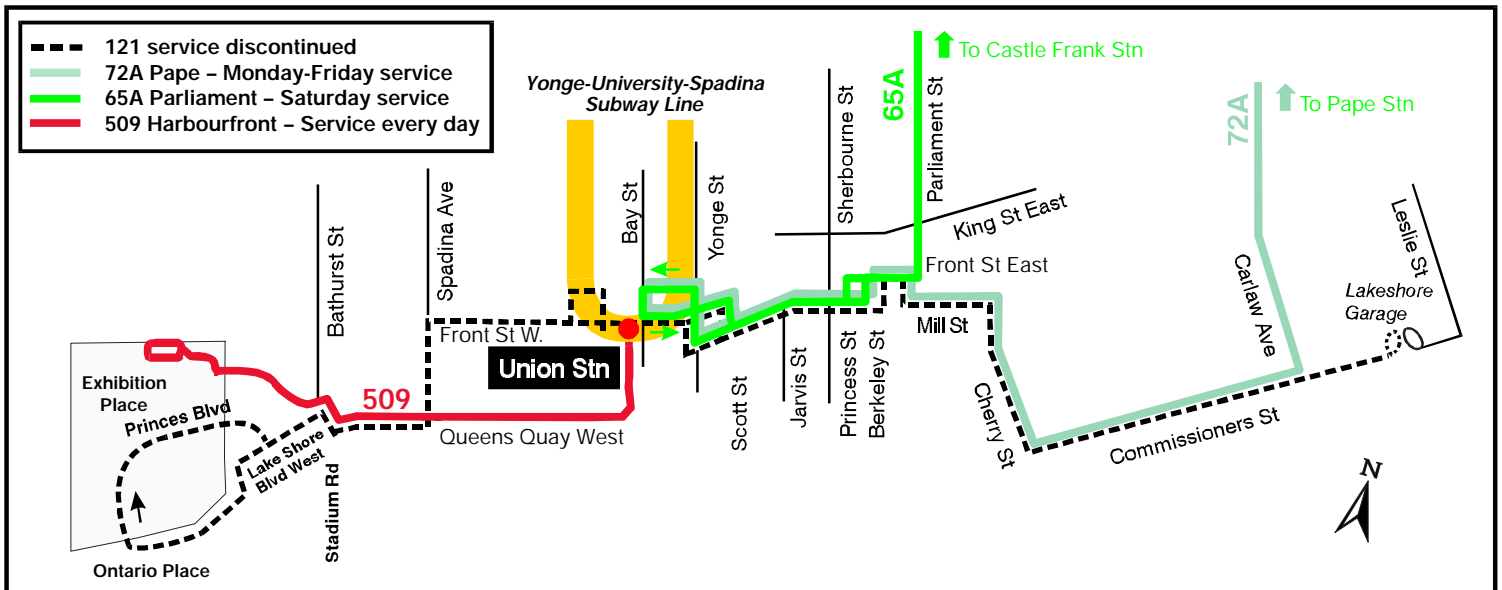
- Route 72A PAPE runs every 17 - 24 minutes.

**Saturday (5:18 a.m. - 6:10 p.m.)**

- Route 65A PARLIAMENT runs every 16 minutes.

**Sunday**

- There is no Sunday service.

Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

**TTC's Blue Night Network**

Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
