TRACK IMPROVEMENTS QUEEN and SHAW INTERSECTION October 19 to October 24, 2000

WORK PLANNED:

Toronto Works and Emergency Services with the Toronto Transit Commission will rebuild the streetcar tracks at the intersection of Queen Street West and Shaw Street. This work will complete the major track replacement projects on Queen Street for the year 2000.

TIMEFRAME:

Work to replace the streetcar tracks at this intersection will be conducted with a complete closure from 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 19, 2000 to 5:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 24, 2000.

WORK HOURS:

To complete this work in the shortest possible time, work will be conducted around-the-clock. Work associated with rail replacement will involve some overnight activities by TTC track staff, including delivery of rail material, rail installation and welding. This work is being conducted in co-operation with the City of Toronto.

TRANSIT SERVICE CHANGES:

- **501/301 Queen streetcars** will divert around the Queen/Shaw intersection bothways via: Spadina Avenue, King Street West and The Queensway to regular routing. Full streetcar service on Queen Street will resume on the morning of Tuesday, October 24, 2000.
- **Replacement bus service** on Queen Street West during this project will not be provided.
- **63/316 Ossington buses** will divert around the Queen/Shaw intersection bothways via: Queen Street West, Dovercourt Road, Sudbury Street and King Street West to regular routing.
