## February 13, 2000 Service Changes

### TTC makes room for more passengers during subway rush hours

The TTC has added subway trains to reduce crowding on the Yonge-University-Spadina (Y-U-S) line during morning and afternoon rush hours. Two trains, with a total capacity of 2400, began service this morning and three trains, with 3600 capacity, begin operation this afternoon. Rush hour trains are about 2 1/2 minutes apart.

Customers looking to further ease their rush hour travel are advised to leave 10 minutes early, arriving at Bloor-Yonge before 8:15 a.m. and to move to the south end of the Y-U-S platforms, to access the less full subway cars.

Midday service has also increased by one train. To cut the wait time between trains to less than 5 minutes, weekend service and after-10 p.m. service daily have been boosted by four trains.

### Service Summary

Weekday and Saturday service starts about 6:00 a.m. Sunday service starts about 9:00 a.m. (Holiday start times vary; Call 393-4636) Last trains leave the Downtown area about 1:30 a.m. every day. The times listed below are accurate at time of printing. See specific schedules posted at DWA platform locations.
